
Decision No. 33437

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Investigation by the Commission on its own motion into the operative rights of common carriers engaged in transporting property by vessel between points on San Francisco, San Pablo and Suisun Bays, and on the San Joaquin, Sacramento and Napa Rivers and Petaluma Creek and their tributaries.



BY THE COMMISSION:

THIRD SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER.

Decision No. 29778 in this proceeding (40 C.R.C. 493) defined the common carrier by vessel operative rights of Frank Brown, as of June 16, 1936, as consisting of authority to transport property between Delta points, Clarksburg and south. Brown has informed the Commission that he has discontinued his common carrier operations.

This discontinuance of service has not left shippers without a means of transportation, since the territory affected is served by other carriers. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Frank Brown's operative rights as a common carrier by vessel be and they are hereby revoked and annulled and that his tariffs on file with the Commission be and they are hereby canceled.

The territory embraced by the term "Delta" is described in Footnote 6 of Decision No. 28282 in this proceeding (39 C.R.C. 429).

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
