O R D E R

The Department of Public Works of the State of California is authorized to construct a military access road at grade across a main line track of Southern Pacific Company near Linda Corners, Yuba County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. C-139.3. Said crossing is to be constructed with funds made available by the Federal Government. Maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails shall be borne by Yuba County. Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Width of crossing shall be not less than 66 feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. 72. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
