In the Matter of the Application of PACIFIC ELECTRIC RAILWAY COMPANY, a corporation, for authority to construct, maintain and operate a railroad side track upon and across 14th Street on its Santa Monica Air Line. } Application No. 24970.

BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct a side track at grade across 14th Street in Santa Monica, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 6A-16,78. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without super-elevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding 3%. Protection shall be by existing protective devices.

Within 30 days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
