ORDER AMENDING DECISION AND DENVING PETITION FOR REHEARING

A petition has been filed by Eastside Building Materials Co., Inc., and Eastside Hauling Co., Inc., for a rehearing of Decision No. 35342 issued May 12, 1942. Such petition has been fully considered. The intent of the order contained in said decision was to direct respondents Nichol, Janes and Wladyka to discontinue the practice of according special rates upon shipments ostensively tendered by Eastside Hauling Co., Inc., but actually the shipments of Eastside Building Materials Co., Inc. The direction made in the second ordering paragraph that undercharges on past shipments be collected from Eastside Building Materials Co., Inc., was in error. This error may be corrected by merely eliminating any reference to past charges.

With such a change made in the order, the Commission is of the opinion that no good reason appears for the granting of a rehearing; therefore, IT IS ORDERED that the second ordering paragraph of the order

contained in Decision No. 35342 be and hereby is rescinded. In other respects said decision shall remain in full force and effect.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER OFDERED that the petition of Eastside Building Materials Co., Inc., and Eastside Hauling Co., Inc., be and hereby is denied.
