O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a pass-
ing track at grade across Hunts Lane near Loma Linda, San Bernardino
County, at the location described in the application, to be identified
as a portion of Crossing No. B-541.0.

Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance
expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior
to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superlevation and of a
width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops
of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding
one per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 3 signals
(G.O. No. 75-B). Applicant shall improve view conditions by trimming
trees adjacent to highway north of the crossing.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order
applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authoriza-
tion shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time
be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authoriza-
tion may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or
safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
