SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By Decision No. 35105, dated March 10, 1942, the Commission granted a certificate to William Williford authorizing the establishment and operation of a passenger stage service between Guadalupe and Camp Cooke. Service regulation No. 3 of the order of that Decision requires the applicant to prepare and file with the Commission tariffs and time schedules within 120 days from the effective date of Decision No. 35105. Applicant now requests an extension of thirty (30) days within which to comply with that regulation. Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that service regulation No. 3, at page 3, of Decision No. 35105, dated March 10, 1942, is hereby amended to provide that applicant, William Williford, shall comply therewith within one hundred fifty (150) days from the effective date of said Decision No. 35105 and on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Commission and the public.
