O R D E R

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Congress Junction for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof as a Class "A" non-agency station is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to change its non-agency station of Congress Junction, Santa Clara County, from a Class "A" to a Class "E" non-agency station, and to cancel all freight tariffs applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after the change, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
