O R D E R

Sacramento Northern Railway is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across State Highway 7 (U. S. 40), near Vacaville, Solano County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. 8G-4.3. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be in accordance with the permit from the Division of Highways attached to the application, with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 5 crossing signals (G. O. No. 75-B), now in place but to be relocated and controlled so as to give warning of movements on the track herein authorized.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
