crity to (a) abandon its Class "B" freight Application No. 25131
station at Ali, County of Mendocino, State
of California, and (b) to abandon and re-
move a spur track approximately 429 feet
in length, located at said station.

BY THE COMMISSION

O R D E R

The verified application of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company discloses that no freight business has been transacted at applicant's station of Ali for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its Class "B" freight station of Ali, County of Mendocino, to remove a spur track at said station, to eliminate said name from its station records, and to cancel all freight tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
