BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of certain interchange tracks, drill track and crossover track upon, along and across First and Adeline Streets, in the City of Oakland, County of Alameda, State of California.

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct two side tracks and to relocate an existing track at grade across Adeline Street in Oakland, Alameda County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. D-5-9. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding one per cent. Protection shall be determined by further order in this proceeding.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
