ORDER

The City of Larkspur is authorized to construct a pedestrian crossing with a branch line of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company near Baltimore Park Station, Marin County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. 5E-12.9-D. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, also maintenance cost outside of lines two feet outside of rails. Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company shall bear maintenance cost between such lines. Construction shall be as shown on plan accompanying the application. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O. 75-3).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
