BY THE COMMISSION:

SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

By Decision No. 34297 Asbury Rapid Transit System was authorized to operate via the Southern Pacific Company depot at Glendale certain of its schedules which provide service between Pasadena, Arcadia, Hollywood and Ocean Park for a temporary period of six months. Thereafter by Decision No. 34895, dated December 30, 1941 that applicant was authorized to continue that service for an additional six months trial period which expired June 30, 1942.

Applicant now requests authority to continue that service for an additional period of time until January 1, 1943, stating in support thereof that there is a continuing public demand for that service.

It appears that this is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary, and the authority requested to continue the service for an additional trial period is in the public interest and should be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that Asbury Rapid Transit System may, in addition to operation over its present route, continue to provide service on its Pasadena, Hollywood, Ocean Park division via Gardena Avenue, Central Avenue, Railroad Street, Cerritos Avenue, Gardena Avenue, Central Avenue and Gardena Avenue to Los Feliz Boulevard, in the city of Glendale subject to the following condition:

The foregoing authority expires January 1, 1943 unless extended by further order of the Railroad Commission.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that as a service regulation, applicant shall comply with the provisions of General Order No. 79 and Part IV of General Order No. 93-A within fifteen (15) days from and after the effective date hereof and upon at least five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public.

The effective date of this order shall be the date hereof.
