ORDER

It appears from the above entitled application that the two parcels of land owned by Pacific Electric Railway Company, as more particularly described in Paragraph III of the application and as shown in tinted red on the drawing (C.E.H. 16812), attached to the application, are no longer necessary for railroad purposes, and that the sale of these parcels will not inconvenience the passenger or shipping public.

Good Cause Appearing, Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to dispose of said property by sale (Parcel 1 to Mrs. Malveana Gannum, or nominee, and Parcel 2 to Nelle I. Adams), substantially in accordance with the terms proposed in the application.

Applicant shall, within thirty days thereafter, notify this Commission in writing of the completion of the property transfer herein authorized. This authorization shall become void if not

exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.
