BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

By the above numbered application Southern Pacific Company seeks the Commission's authority to remove a spur track some 533 feet in length at its station of Oliva in Santa Barbara County. The removal as proposed will make available for relay purposes substantial quantities of rail and other miscellaneous material. In each of the years 1938, 1940 and 1941 only one car was handled over this spur, and none was handled during the year 1939.

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to abandon and remove its spur track 533 feet in length, located at mile post 367.9 on its main line at Oliva Station, Santa Barbara County, as more definitely described in the application.

Within 30 days after abandonment and removal, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This Order shall be effective immediately.
