## O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Doyle Street and two spur tracks across 45th Street in Emeryville, Alameda County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as Crossings Nos. A-7.67-C and A-7.71-C, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation, and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with readway and with grades of approach not exceeding four per cent. Protection shall be by one Standard No. 1 crossing sign (G.O. No. 75-B) at Crossing No. A-7.67-C, and by two such signs at Crossing No. A-7.71-C.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
