OPINION

C. J. McIntosh, by virtue of authority granted him in Decision No. 21698, dated October 21, 1929, on Application No. 15965, has been operating an automotive service for the transportation of property between San Diego and Dehesa and Jamacha Valleys, California. The operating right so acquired was originally established by our Decision No. 15533, dated October 15, 1925, on Application No. 11505.

Applicant herein requests authority to discontinue and abandon the service above described, alleging as justification for such abandonment that the operation is producing no revenue whatsoever. It would appear from the information of record that the principal commodities transported by applicant were milk and other dairy products and that such business as he had, has virtually all been lost to him. Under these circumstances it appears that public interest will be served by the granting of the application, and it will be so ordered. This is not a matter in which a public hearing is necessary.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that C. J. McIntosh be and he is hereby authorized to discontinue and abandon all of his automotive service for the transportation of property between San Diego and Dehesa and Jamacha Valleys, California.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the operative right created by Decision No. 15533 be and it is hereby revoked and annulled and all tariffs and time schedules filed thereunder are cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be ten (10) days from the date hereof.
