OPINION AND ORDER

E. Powers is the sole shareholder of Manteca Warehouse, Inc., a corporation operating as a public utility warehouseman at Manteca. By this application authority is sought to transfer the properties which are necessary or useful in the performance of the corporation's duties as a public utility from the corporation to Powers.¹ Powers also seeks authority to adopt the corporation's tariff naming rates for the service involved. No change or interruption in the service to the public is proposed.

It appears that this is a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Manteca Warehouse, Inc., a corporation, be and it is hereby authorized to transfer its public utility warehouse property located at Manteca to E. Powers, an individual, in accordance with the terms of the proposed arrangements as set forth in the above entitled application and Exhibit "A" thereto.

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The property proposed to be transferred consists of two warehouse structures, the land on which they are situated, and warehouse equipment and fixtures. This property is more fully described and the terms and conditions of the proposed transfer are set forth in the application and exhibits attached thereto.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that immediately upon the transfer of the aforesaid warehouse property, tariffs on file with the Commission naming rates, rules and regulations covering the warehouse operations involved shall be amended, on not less than five (5) days' notice to the Commission and to the public, to show that Manteca Warehouse, Inc., a corporation, has withdrawn from or cancelled said rates, rules and regulations and that E. Powers, an individual, has concurrently adopted or established them as his own; and that the tariff filings made pursuant to this order shall, in other respects, comply with the regulations governing the construction and filing of warehouse tariff set forth in the Commission's General Order No. 61.

This order shall become effective twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
