O R D E R

In this application the Pacific Electric Railway Company requests permission to abandon certain auxiliary tracks on its system. Applicant alleges that no industry will be adversely affected by the removal of such trackage and that it is not presently needed for the company's operations.

This appears to be a matter in which a public hearing is not necessary and that the application should be granted, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Pacific Electric Railway Company be and it is hereby authorized to abandon those certain spur tracks and other incidental trackage, as shown on Exhibit "A" attached to and made a part of the application, and to remove the rails and appurtenances thereto.
