Decision No. 35774

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order modifying Decision No. 35378 of the Railroad Commission of the State of California, dated May 19, 1942, with reference to the curtailment or elimination of certain crossing protection on lines over which Interurban Electric Railway Company formerly operated in Alameda County, Californoa.

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern Pacific Company, by its First Supplemental Order, requests authority to remove the wigway signals from the following crossings:

Shattuck Avenue Line:

A-7.21-C Green Street and Stanford Avenue

Ninth Street Line:

A-7.37-C 59th Street A-7.60-C 63rd Street A-7.95-C 67th Street

By Decision No. 35378, dated May 19, 1942, the Commission denied authority to remove these wigwags. Southern Pacific Company now alleges that only occasional switching movements operate over these crossings and that the City of Emeryvilder is agreeable to the removal of these signals. It appears that under the present conditions the request should be granted provided suitable fixed signs are installed in lieu thereof.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that that portion of Decision No. 35378 reading as follows:

"Authority to remove the wigwags now in place at Crossings Nos. A-7.21-C, A-7.37-C, A-7.60-C, and A-7.95-C is denied." be and it is hereby rescinded and of no further force and effect.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that Southern Pacific Company be and it is hereby authorized to remove all wigwag signals at the above mentioned crossings provided they be protected as follows:

Shattuck Avenue Line A-7.21-C, Green Street at Stanford, shall be protected by 2 reflectorized special crossing signs as shown by C.E. Drawing 10333, sheet 2, as attached to and made a part of the application.
