OPINION AND ORDER

In this application Southern California Edison Company Ltd. requests authority to enter into a written agreement with the United States of America relating to the sale and delivery of electrical energy as shall, during the term of the agreement, be required for light and power in a housing development located in the City of Compton (Identification No. C/L-4105). A copy of the proposed agreement marked Exhibit "A" is attached to and made a part of the application.

Some of the more important features and conditions of the aforesaid agreement may be here set forth.

The utility agrees to supply electrical energy for light and power for the requirements of the housing development and of the tenants of the development, in accordance with the rules and regulations of the utility on file with this Commission. The utility further agrees that it shall, without expense to the government, provide, operate and maintain all facilities for supplying and metering the electrical energy to the point of delivery.

The government agrees to purchase and pay for the electrical energy furnished by the utility through a master meter installation in accordance with the terms of the tariff set forth hereinafter. Furthermore the agreement provides that the government shall furnish, construct,

own and operate the development's complete and entire electrical primary and secondary distribution system from the point of delivery.

The special rates to be paid and the special conditions relating to said rates are set forth and made a part of Exhibit "A." The rate portion provides as follows:

(a) Rate L-2

Minimum Charge \$1.00 per month

For all single phase power service connected in excess of 3 hp., an additional minimum charge of \$1.00 per hp. per month.

(b) Revision of Rates

If, during the period of this contract, increased or reduced rates are made applicable to service of the type supplied hereunder, such increased or decreased rates shall be applicable to the service supplied under this contract.

The term of the agreement is for a period of one year from the execution thereof and in the absence of notice of intention to terminate, served on either party by the other, at least thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of the agreement, shall continue for another year and from year to year thereafter until terminated by notice as further outlined in the agreement.

It is noted that reference to this Commission's jurisdiction has been omitted from the agreement and the Commission at this time calls to the attention of both parties to the contract the fact that each may expect the Commission to continue to exercise its jurisdiction over the rates, conditions and terms of service rendered thereunder in accordance with the statutes.

The Commission having considered the request of applicant, and it being of the opinion that the application should be granted, that a public hearing in the matter is not necessary, and good cause appearing, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Southern California Edison Company Ltd. is hereby authorized to enter into that certain agreement with the United States of America attached to this application and marked Exhibit "A" and to render electric service to the housing development designated as Identification No. CAL-4105 at the rates and under the terms and conditions set forth in said agreement.

Authority herein granted shall become effective as of the date hereof.
