SECOND SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decisions Nos. 35487 and 35624 The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company was authorized to construct a second main track at grade across various streets in San Diego, and these decisions prescribe certain protection. The second track is now completed and ready for operation but the additional protection has not been installed due to delay in obtaining critical materials. Applicant has requested permission to operate over the second track pending completion of the crossing protection as required in our orders.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Atchison, Topeka and Santa Fe Railway Company is authorized to operate over the second track crossings heretofore authorized in this proceeding pending completion of the installation of protection required in Decisions Nos. 35487 and 35624, provided the existing protection at the crossings involved is connected to the second track.

This authority shall expire six months from the date hereof.
