Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grado across Lay Avenue, near Red Bluff, Tehama County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. C-222.6-C. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superclovation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with readway and with grades of approach not exceeding three per cent. Protection shall be by two Standard No. 2 crossing signs (G.O. No. 75-B).

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
