O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Seaver Avenue, in Richmond, Contra Costa County, at the location described in the application.

Said avenue is not traveled at the point of crossing and this order shall not be construed as authorizing the opening of a crossing of Seaver Avenue with the track herein under consideration. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
