FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good Cause Appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, that Condition
 No. 4 of the Commission's Decision No. 24521, dated February 29, 1932,
 in the above entitled application be modified to read as follows:

"Said crossing shall be protected by standard
 signals in accordance with a plan to be approved
 by the Commission, said plan to be presented by
 applicant. The expense of providing such sig-
 nals shall be borne by applicant, and the expense
 of maintaining the same shall be borne by Southern
 Pacific Company."

In all other respects Decision No. 24521 shall remain in
 full force and effect.
