O R D E R

Central California Traction Company has applied for authority to abandon its agency at Sheldon, Sacramento County. The application recites that this agency has in the past been operated primarily in connection with a warehouse which has been taken over by the United States Government for storage purposes and that as a result the agency is no longer necessary.

It appears that carload business consists of an occasional car and that the less-than-carload revenue amounts to less than \$40.00 per month. The closing of said agency will not involve the abandonment of any facilities, and the station will be continued as a non-agency station. The nearest agencies are at Sacramento approximately 17 miles to the north, and Lodi 20 miles to the south.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Central California Traction Company is authorized to abandon its agency at Sheldon, Sacramento County, and to change its station records and tariffs accordingly, provided, that said station be continued as a non-agency station. Applicants shall give 'ten days' notice to the public and this Commission of the abandonment of said agency, reporting to the Commission within thirty (30) days thereafter.

The authority herein granted shall become effective on the

date hereof.
