ORDER

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company asks permission to sell to The United States of America - Department of the Navy, the following distribution plant situate on Treasure Island Naval Reservation:

The distribution plant is used in furnishing telephone service to the United States Navy and to certain Navy contractors and others located on Treasure Island. A list of subscribers other than the United States Navy is filed in this proceeding as Exhibit A.

It is reported that all of the services are directly or indirectly related to Government operations and that applicant will continue to furnish the subscribers on Treasure Island telephone service subject to the permit given by the United States Navy. It is further reported that the United States Navy has tentatively agreed to pay for the properties \$9,475.94, which amount represents the estimated original cost of the properties as of June 24, 1942.

The Commission has considered applicant's request and is of the opinion that this is not a matter on which a hearing is necessary, and that this application should be granted, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company be, and it is hereby, authorized to sell, on or before December 31, 1942, to The United States of America - Department of the Navy, the properties referred to herein and described in Exhibit C on file in this proceeding.

IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED that the authority herein granted will become effective upon the date hereof.
