No. 17681, Southern Paciffc Comphy maintains a seasonal agency station at Madison, Yolo County, during the period from approximately August lst of each yeor to December lst. In the present application Southern Pacific Company requests authority to discontinue this soasonal agency, dileging that under exiating conditions the amount of business handled at Madison during the four-month poriod no longer requires the maintenanceror an agoncy.

The statoment ifiled with the application shows that during this four-month period in 1940 but 130 shipments wero reccived and forwaraed, and that durine the same poriod in 1941, I49 shipments were handiod. The nearcet aeoncies are at Isparto, 3.1 miles to the East (railroad direction) and Wintors, 10.8 miles to the Wost. The abandonment of soid agcnes will not involve tho abandonment of any facilitios, and the station will bo continucd as a non-agency.

It appearing that a pubilc hoaring is not necossary herein and that tho application should be granted,

IN IS ERREBII ORDENED that Southom Pacific Company is hereby autiorized to abancon its agency at Madison on ite Esparto Branch, Yolo County, and to change its station rocords and tarifis accordingiy, provided that said station bo continucd as a non-agency.
