FOURTH SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

A written request having been filed for a supplemental order extending the time for the commencement of service authorized by Decision No. 33804, in the above-entitled proceeding, and it appearing that because of a labor shortage, the completion of the new highway over which such service was to be conducted will be further delayed,

IT IS ORDERED that conditions Nos. 3 and 4 of the order in Decision No. 33804 are further amended to provide that Pacific Greyhound Lines shall comply therewith by commencing said service on or before December 31, 1942 and by filing tariffs and time schedules effective upon five (5) days' notice to the Commission and the public.
