BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a passing track extension at grade across Meridian Avenue, Rancho Avenue, 3rd Street and 4th Street in Colton, San Bernardino County, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as portions of crossings Nos. B-537.5, B-538.2, B-538.4 and B-538.5, respectively. Applicant shall bear the entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of widths to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadways and with grades of approach not exceeding 4%. Protection shall be as follows:

- Crossing No. B-537.5 two Standard No. 1 crossing signs
- Crossing No. B-538.2 two Standard No. 1 crossing signs
- Crossing B-538.4 two Standard No. 5 flashing light signals
- Crossing No. B-538.5 two Standard No. 1 crossing signs

Within thirty days after completion, pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
