

DECISION NO. 35866

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing it to (a) reclassify its Class "C" non-agency Station of Vinvale, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, to a Class "C" non-agency station for handling business to and from the Rio Grande Oil Company only, and modify its tariffs accordingly, and (b) to abandon and remove a team track siding approximately 766 feet in length located at said station.

ORDER

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that but nine carloads of freight have been handled at applicant's Class "C" non-agency station of Vinvale for more than two years and that continued maintenance thereof for public service is no longer necessary.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to reclassify its Class "C" non-agency station of Vinvale, County of Los Angeles, to a Class "C" non-agency station for handling business to and from the Rio Grande Oil Company only and to modify its tariffs accordingly on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public. Applicant is also authorized to abandon and remove a team track siding approximately 766 feet in length located at said station.

Within thirty days after effecting the reclassification and removal of the facilities as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
