O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across a portion of Seaver Avenue and across 28th Street in Richmond, Contra Costa County, at the locations described in the application. Said streets are not traveled at the point of crossing and no numbers are assigned. This order shall not be deemed as authorizing the opening of said streets across the spur track. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. No additional protection is required.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
