O R D E R

Yosemite Valley Railway Company has applied for authority to close its agency at Incline, Mariposa County. Applicant states that but \$53.07 passenger revenue and \$64.41 freight revenue accrued at said station during the eight-month period ending August 31, 1942; that the principal shippers and receivers of freight at said station have been consulted and offer no objection to the proposal; that the closing of this agency will not involve the abandonment of any facilities; that the station will be continued as a non-agency station; and that less-than-carload shipments will be stored in the company's freight house and the key made available to receivers and shippers of freight. Telephone facilities will be provided whereby shippers may talk direct with representatives of the company.

It appearing that a public hearing is not necessary herein and that the application should be granted,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Yosemite Valley Railway Company is authorized to close its agency at Incline, Mariposa County, and to change its station records and tariffs accordingly on ten days' notice to the public and this Commission, provided that said station shall be continued as a non-agency station.

Applicant shall within thirty (30) days thereafter notify this Commission in writing of the closing of this agency. The authorization herein granted shall lapse and become void if not exercised within one (1) year from the date hereof unless further time is granted by subsequent order.

This order is effective on the date hereof.
