OPINION.
In the above ontitied applications, es amended, Lassen Trailways, a passenger stage corporation, successor to Twin Cities Transit, providing local transportation in and between the cities of Marysville and Tube City, seeks an order authorizing:
(I) A clarification of its operating rights as granted in Decision No. 34969, in regard to intracity sorrice.(1)
(II) The extension of its service as requested in Application No. $252 \hat{N}_{4}, \varepsilon 3$ emended.
(III) The abandonment of service on D Street between Fifth and Fourtconth Streets and on Fourteenth Street from $D$ to $B$ Streots. (2)
(1) By Docks ion No. 34969, Application No. 24554, Sacramento Northern Rollway was euthorizod to obendon ail local street ear service between Marysville and Tuba city, and by the same decision, Application No. 2h492, authorized Twin Cities Transit, prodecosoor to Lesson Trailways, to opurotc a local paseorger stage service between the cities of marysville and tuba city.
(2) By Decision No. 35313, Appircation No. 24P80, Lassen Trailways was granted authority to extend service north of the Marysville terminus from fth Street to 14 th Street via D in B Streets.

Radial oporctions within a distance of threo blocks of the cortificated route in the city of Maryovilile for the trensportation of school childron.
(v) An incroose in fares to 10 cents for singlo rides, with a 15-ride ticket to bo sold at $\$ 1.00$ for aduits or 60 cente for children ettondine school.

Pubilc horinge in these procectings, which were consolidntod for both horring and decistion, wore held before Examiner Grant In Marysulilio on Soptomber 21, 19l4, and in Sm Frencisco on Soptembor 28, 2942, the metters wore submittod, ond aro now rendy for decisinn.

Durine the course of those procecdings tho prosicent of Insson Troilways testitilod gonorally es to the neturo of the applicetions, introducing a number of achibsts in support or his cinims. An oecountant in the employ on applicort tostiricd as to the operating rovenuos and oxpenscs of the applicent ond an ongineor from the commission's staff aiso testiflod R2ons theso linos, both subuitting exhibite. Thirteen public witnoscos reprosenting, omong others, local military cuthoritics, city and school orifcicis, and reprosontativos of civic bodios testified.

Thoso motters are interrejeted and of common interost. For tho sake of cierity, however, they will bo diecucsed seperstely in oreor of their numorical scoucnce, an individual findine mode thorein, and will thercofter be disposed of in e single decision.
I. CLARTFICATION OF CPERETING RIGETS

With rospoct to applicent's recucst to elarify operating rights within the cities, tho Comission, in Decision No. 34969, grantod a certificoto of public convenionco nid nocossity to Twin Cities Trensit, prodecessor of Lissen Treilways, for the operation of
a locel passenger stige service between the cities of Marysulale and Yube City but the decision was silent as to the service within the cities. foplicant stajed that it was his intent to perform service Within each city as well es betweon citios and wis of the belief thet It was the Commission's intent to erent such cuthority. Ee requests, therefore, thet Docision No. 34969 be amenced to read "For the operation of 20c9l onsecnger service betweon the cities of Marysville and Yuba City and within ecich of tho two citios." Io furthor stetod that he is now performing such scruico and sooks e clarificotion of the right to do so. Besed on tho record, applicant's roquest for such clarification appears to bo recsoneble and in the public interest and he will be grantod authority to porform sorwico betweon and within Marysvillo and Yube City.
II. EXTENSION OF SERVICE SOUGET BY APPIICRMION NO. 25224.

Tostimony of $\begin{aligned} \\ \text { itincsses, including representotives of the }\end{aligned}$ Army enc civic groups, showed that the proposed extension would provide transportation acrvice to a traijer camp, consizting of 200 tresiers orectce by the Fedcral Government, winch houses the civilian employees of camp secio. (3) It wns also pointce out that tho proposec extenoion would servo somo 300 homes, now constmated, or in the courso of construction, wich are to be oceupiod principcily by officers and onlisted mon of Camp Bealo and thoir families. There is no pubilc transportation servico now available in the ares under consideration. No opposition to the proposed extengion of sorvice appeers of rocord. This recuest will bo granted.
III. ABANDONRENT OF SERVICE ON D STREET AND I4th STREET.

In tho mattor of ebondoning sorvico on $D$ Strect betweon
Fifth and Fourtecnth Streots and on Fourtecntin Streot botween $D$ and $B$
(3) Comp Boale, recentiy constructoc necr Marysvilic, is one of the larger contomonts on the coust.

Streets (4) applicant testifica thet becruse of ineufficient patronage, sorvico had olrocidy becn curtifled to three tripe difly end evon thoso cerried only a smell percontece of capecity. Wisth the grenting of tho oxtoncion of sorvico along 3 strcot tho comencomont of service on D Street will not be a serious inconvonience. Tho pubile not being adversely affected and in the intcrest of economy end of consorvetion of oquipment mind rubbor, tho raquost for aberdionment will bo granted.

In order to accompise tho cincification of operativo rights, extonsion of sorvice sought by Appli ertion No. 25224 and the abandonment of sorvice on D Strest and lith Strect as above aiscussed,
 prosent oporntive rights botween Marysville and Yuba City.

## IV. RADILI OPERATIONS WITEIN MEREE BIOCKS OF CERTIFICKTED ROUSE.

Applicant secks authority, by vorbol amondment to his applicotion noer the closc of tostimony, to devieto an atanec of threc blocks radielly from his cortificeted routc to accomodate school children cttondins tho Neryevilic clementary school and Notro Damo Convont. Testimong in support of euch requist consistod only of a statement by applicent thet school. authoritics hed osked for this servico. The record is silent $a s$ to the possible number of students who would avail themselves of the service, the time required to porform the samc, and the number of trips which might bo involvod. Neithor doos the rocord eiscloso whether equipment ovailablo to applicont would be adequete to hendie this sorvico without joopardizing other schodulod operetions. zesod en the condition of the rocord with respect to this requect, it wil bo donice witiout prejudico.
(4) That portion of the scrvico sought to be fonndonce wes granted in Decision No. 35313, Application No. 24\&80.
V. INCREASE IN FARES.

Because of the need for immediate service over the new routes requestec by sppifcent authority for such service wil be gronted in the followng interim orcer, which wil in turn be followed at a later dote by an oncien cealing vi th epplicant's request for an incresse in fores.

Public hocring having been held in the above entitled proceedings, eviecnco heving been recoived, the matter having been duly submittod, the Commission now boine fully acrised, end it being found as a fret thot puific conventence one neccselty so require:

IT IS ORDERED:

Thet a certizicato of public convenience and necossity is heroby grented to Lussen Treizveys to operate c pessenger bus sorvice betweon snd within the citios of Moryiville and Yube oity'amdintermodiate points, not in addition to, but in lieu of the operativo rishts heretoforc crectea or scquired by appilcent under Decision No. 34969, dated Jonumry 27, 1942, ond Docision No. 35313, cated Nay 5, 1942, which operotive rigits sre horeby revokod and snnulled, subject to the followng condition:

> Losson Treilweys, its successors or assigns, mov nover cicim bofore this commision or any coumt or other public cody, a valuc, for cny pungose, for tho cortificato horcin srantod in cxcess of tho actuol cost incurred by it in socuring seid oporetive authority.

## II

That in proviafng sorvice, pursunt to tho foregoing certificato, tho followng servico nesulntions shell bo observod:

1. Applicont shali filo a writion accoptmoce of tho cortificato hercin granted within a poriod of not to oxcoed thirty (30) days from the offective deto hercof.
2. Applicont shall comply uith the malos of tho Comission's fenoral ordor No. 93-A, Part IV, by filing, in triplicato, and concurrontly meking offective timo schedules setis factory to tho Commission within sixty (60) dojs from the offcetivo drto heroof and on not loss then ifve (5) cays' notice to tho Commiseion and the public.
3. Subjoct to the authority of the Commission to chonse or modify such at ony time by further order, cpolicent shell concuct sold passenesr stege operrtions over rac clons the following routos:

Commenng at the wost or Yube Citr ond of the Bridge which crossos the Fosther Rivir betwoon Marysville and Yuba City, thonce westerly on Bridec Stroet to and Stregt, southerly ilong 2nd Streot to B Strect, westeriy along B Strect to cooper Avonuo, northerly nione Cooper Avenue to Forbos Avonue, ecstcrly ilong Forbos Avonuo to Plumas Stroot, northeriy rilong Plumes Stroot to Teegarcen Avenuo, ensteriy on Icogarden Avonuo to Suttor Stroct, southorly on Sutter Streot to Briego Stroot, thonce across the Brideg to 5th strcot, in Marysulilo, thonco oosteriy rions 5th Stroct to B Stroct, nortion IF cloms B Stroot to IEth Street, ocstoriy $=100 \mathrm{~g}$ 28th Strcet to Remirez Strcot, southerly ciong Ramircz Strout to l2th Stroet, wosterly along leth Strect to $\bar{I}$ Streot, southorly on 3 Strect to 5th Strect, and thonce along 5th Strect to the point of beginning,
