SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

In Decision No. 35871 of October 20, 1942, in this proceeding, the Commission established reduced rates for the towing of vehicles and the transportation of wine. Through inadvertence application of the rate on vehicles was not restricted to towing operations and the rates on wine were not limited to shipments having a declared value of not more than \$2 per gallon. This inadvertence should be corrected.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the provisions of the first ordering paragraph of Decision No. 35871 of October 20, 1942, in the above entitled proceeding relating to the further amendment of Exhibit "A" of Decision No. 28632, as amended, reading "Wine, in glass in boxes3" and "Vehicles containing the means for their own propulsion\$1.50 per vehicle" be and they are hereby changed to read "Wine, having a declared value of not more than \$2 per gallon, in glass in boxes3" and "Vehicles containing the means for their own propulsion towed by the carrier's equipment....\$1.50 per vehicle."

In all other respects said Decision No. 35871 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall become effective November 9, 1942.
