SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good Cause Appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the first paragraph of Decision No. 35379 in Application No. 24928, be modified to read as follows:

The People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, are authorized to construct for the United States Government a military access road across the main line of Southern Pacific Company near Wheatland, Yuba County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. C-131-L. Applicant shall bear entire construction expense, and Southern Pacific Company shall bear maintenance expense between lines two feet outside of rails. The maintenance of approaches shall be borne by the County of Yuba. Width of crossing shall not be less than 62 feet and grades of approach not greater than three per cent. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72. As soon as materials are available crossing shall be protected by two Standard No. 8 crossing signals. Pending such installation the crossing shall be protected by two Standard No. 1-A crossing signals. Applicant shall file with the Commission documentary evidence that materials for signals are not available.

In all other respects Decision No. 35379 shall remain in full force and effect.
