In the Matter of the Application of the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, for an order authorizing construction of a crossing at separated grades of the State highway and the tracks of the Western Pacific Railroad, at Sunol, in the County of Alameda, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

In Decision No. 33077 in the above numbered application the People of the State of California, on relation of the Department of Public Works, were authorized to construct a crossing of State highway at separated grades under the main line track of The Western Pacific Railroad Company near Sunol, one of the conditions being that four existing grade crossings in the vicinity be closed. It now appears that applicant will be unable to accomplish the closing of two of these crossings and that the order should be modified accordingly, therefore

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the requirement in Decision No. 33077 that Crossings Nos. D-35.8 and 4-36.1 be closed is eliminated.

In all other respects Decision No. 33077 shall remain in full force and effect.
