SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company on October 14, 1942 requested in writing that Decision No. 35843 dated October 6, 1942, in this proceeding be modified so as to permit installation of Standard No. 8 crossing signals instead of Standard No. 4 crossing signals, and good cause appearing, it is hereby ordered that said decision in so far as protective devices are concerned is hereby modified to read as follows:

Protection shall be by two (2) Standard No. 8 crossing signals (GO No. 75-B) at each crossing.

In all other respects said decision shall remain in full force and effect.

This order shall be effective immediately.
