ORDER OF REVOCATION

By Decision No. 33916, dated February 18, 1941, Manuel Artozqui and Frank Artozqui, partners, were authorized to acquire a certificate of public convenience and necessity authorizing their operation as highway common carriers of livestock. By Decision No. 35112, dated March 10, 1942, they were authorized to suspend that operation temporarily for a period of ninety days. On October 31, 1942 those carriers informed the Commission that they are unable to re-establish that service and have requested the Commission to revoke the operative right therefor. Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that the operative right acquired under the authority of Decision No. 33916, dated February 18, 1941, in Application No. 23889 is hereby revoked and annulled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all tariffs and time schedules on file in the name of Manuel Artozqui and Frank Artozqui, doing business as Artozqui Bros., are hereby cancelled.

The effective date of this order shall be twenty (20) days from the date hereof.
