In the matter of application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing the construction at grade of an industrial spur track across Pacific Avenue, in the City of Burbank, County of Los Angeles, State of California.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across a portion of Pacific Avenue, in Burbank, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application. Pacific Avenue is not traveled at the point of crossing and this order shall not be considered as authorizing the opening of said street to public use and travel across said track. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
