Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across Harrison Street at its intersection with Ninth Street, and a second spur track at grade across Minth Street, in the City of Berkeley, Alameda County, at the location described in tho application, the crossing with Harrison Street to be identified as a portion of Crossing No. A-10.76-C. Ninth Street is not traveled at the point of crossing and this order shall not be deemed authority for opening said street across these spur tracks. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of the crossing with Harrison Street shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, without superelevation and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with readway and with grades of approach not exceeding four per cent. No additional protection is required.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
