## ORIXIOX

Werchants Express Corporation is now providins a hiehway comon carrier scrvice in gencral between San Francisco, South San Francisco, Oakland, Hayweri, Berkeley, Richmond, San Rafael, Orinda, Upton, Eryant and Glorietta and Intermediate points.

In the above-entitied appication that carrier requests a certificate to establish and operate a highway common carrier service betweer Glorietta, Moraga, St. Nary's College, Burton, Railez, Lafayette, \#ldden Valley, Eappy Valuey and Bryant and intermediate points. It also seeks authority to serve points situated within one mile of the main highways between the foregoing points. It seeks that authority $a s$ an extonsion and enlargement of its present operative rights.

A public hearing was heid in this matter before Examiner Paul, at Lafayctte, on November 23, 1942, at the conclusion of which the matter was submitted and is now ready for docision.

The foregoing service would be prowiced at rates not Iower than those prescribed by the Comission in its Decision No. 31606 , as amended. Regular service would be proviced on Honday, Wedmesday and Fricay of each week, with addicional semvice to meet traffic requirements.

Through an opezative witness, it wes show tinat appi1cant is nor providing service at Orinda, Upton, Bryant and Glorietta on Iuesday and Friday of each veer through the use of one type 300 truck (two axies and six wheels) of approximately 8,000 pounds capacity. This truck proceeds from its oarland terminal fuliy loaded. Usuaily about two-thirds of the load is destined to orinda, Upton, 3ryant, Glorietta and other points cost of tie Iow Level tunei. Anv avainable space thereon is used for traneporting trafinc destined to points in North Oariand, west of saic tunel. It is anticipated that sufficient additional traffic destined to points proposed to be served wound completeiy fill the truck in mick event traffic gestined to goints in Morth Oakiand would be trensported on other scheduies of applicant now serving that territory.

Evidence in support of the appiseation was adduced from merchants and others residing at Larayette on in the vicinity thereof and the manger of the subsistence sacilities at st. Dtery's Coliege.

From that evidence it appeare that there is now manntained at St. Maryis College a United States Naval Pre-Fifght Schoo1. Ail the meale of the students both of the college and of the Pre-Fitight School are provided by a party uncer the provision of a contract. Tins contractor is also in cherso of munous other facilities of the school, including laundur, etc. It was skom
that in connection with this service tinis contractor is daily receiving ayproximately 15 tons of supplies. Some of this traific is now being and will continue to be delivered by the vendors. For the most part the remainder of the supplies is transported under contract on equipment procured from the Navy. Some trafile moves over the facilfties of the Sacramento Nortinem and is delivered at liorasa, a, nom-agency station. It was conclusively shown that this service is unstisfactory and numerous instances of delays were cited.

From the testimony of merchants at Lafayette, it mas show that the onlt reguiar comon carrien service of merchandise traffic to this area is that now proviced oy Sacramento Northern Rajimay. No store-ioor picioup and delivery service is available on shipments being delivered by the rail carrier at the Iajayette station at which no agency is maintajned. Each of these witnesses stated that he has a need for a store-door delivery service for incoming sinpments.

From the record It appears that zappy Valley and Eiden Valley are rapidly developin resicicntial comunities winch are in need of the proposed service.

There was no opposition to the granting of this application. The only other comon carriers servins this area are Sacramento Northern Rainway, Railway Express fgency, Incorporated. and Pacific Greyhound Innes. Each of them hes advised the Comission, in writing, thet it would not oppose the granting of the authority sousint.

After full consideration of the evicence in tifis record, the Commssion is of the opinion and so finds that tiene is $e$
public need for the establisment of the service proposed. fecordindy the appication mill be granted.

## Q IDER

A public hearing thercon having been held, the matter duiy submitted, the Comission fully informed, and it being found that pubise convenfence and necessity so require:

IT IS ORDERED that a certificate of public convenfence and necessity is hereby Eranted to Nerchants Express Corporation authorizing the establishment anc operation of service as a highway comon carrier, as definca by section 2-3/4, Rablic. Uti䒑itifes Act, between Glorietta, Moraga, St. Víry's College, Eurton; Pailez, Lafayette, Eicien Valley, Eappy Valley, Bryant and Intermediate points and off-route points within one (I) mile of the highways between the foregoing points, subject to the following condition:
Nerchants Express Corporation, its suecessors or
assigns, may never ciaim before tils Commselon
or any count or other public body, a value, for
any purpose, for the authority heresn granted in
excess of the actual cost thercof iricurred by it.

II IS RURTEER ORDERED that in the operation of said highway common carrier service pursuant to the forezoing certiricate, Nerchants Eppress Corporation shall comply with and observe the followine semice regulations:

1. Applicant shail file a witten acceptance of the certiricate herein granted within a period of not to exceed thirty (30) days from the effective date hereor.
2. Applicant shall comply with the rules of the Comossion's General Onden No. 30 and Part IV of General order No. $93-\mathrm{A}$ by filink, in triplicate, and concurrentiy making effective, tarisis and time schedules satisfactory to the Commission within sixty (60) days from the effective date hereof and on not less than one (1) day's notice to the Comission and the pubise.
3. Subject to the authority of this commission to chanee or modify them at any time by further order, applicant shall conduct said highway common carrier operations over and aiong the following routes:

Between Glorietita and Iafayette over and alone Moraga Road via lioraga, St. Nary's College and Burton. Over Jonas Hill Road between Moraga and Lafayette. Over Circle Creek Road between its junction with Moraga Road near Eurton ard its juction with Calsfornia State route 24. Over Eappy valley Road between its fumetion with state route 24 at Iarayette and its gunction with said road about 2 miles westerly of Iafayette. Over Fidden Valley Road between its intersection with State route 24 apporimately $1 \frac{1}{2}$ miles northeasterly of Bryant and its southern termination in Eiccen Valley. over California State route 24 between Bryant and its intersection with Circie Creek Road.

The effective date of this order shail be the date hereof.
