SUPPLEMENTAL OPINION AND ORDER

By prior orders in this proceeding the Commission has established minimum rates, rules and regulations governing the transportation of livestock between all points in California except where both points of origin and destination are within the same incorporated city or within a defined portion of Los Angeles County known as the Los Angeles Drayage Area.

Harris & Fish, Inc. requests that shipments of livestock transported between its cattle feeding yard located at 5440 Southern Avenue, Southgate, and the Los Angeles Drayage Area be exempted from the established minimum rates. Petitioner states that its feeding yard is located approximately one-fourth mile from the boundary of the Los Angeles Drayage Area while those of its competitors are located within the area; that, because minimum rates have not been

The Los Angoles Drayage Area is described in Items Nos. 30 to 33 series, inclusive, of City Carriers' Tariff No. 4 - Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 5 (Appendix "A" of Decision No. 32504, as smended, in Case No. 4121).

Drayage Area, these competitors, by virtue of their location, enjoy rates for the transportation of livestock within the drayage area which are considerably lower than the minimum rates which applicant must pay on shipments between its feeding yard and that area; and that this rate situation has resulted in injury to its business.

It appears that this is not a matter requiring a public hearing and that exemption on shipments of livestock transported between petitioner's feeding lot and points within the Los Angeles Drayage Area is necessary to accord petitioner competitive equality with like feeding lots located within said drayage area. The request will be granted.

By Decision No. 35201 in this proceeding the established minimum truck rates for other than the any-quantity rate bracket, were increased 12½ per cent. In effecting the adjustment rates higher than the corresponding any-quantity rates were inadvertently published on sheep under the 12,000-pound weight bracket for distances over 40 but not over 130 miles. Appropriate tariff corrections will be made.

Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS MEREBY ORDERED that Highway Carriers' Tariff No. 3 (Appendix "C" to Decision No. 31924, as amended) be and it is hereby amended by substituting therein to become effective January 1, 1943, the revised pages attached hereto and by reference made a part hereof, which pages are numbered as follows:
