FIRST SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

(1) That Decision No. 35991, rendered December 1, 1942, in the above-entitled proceeding, be and it hereby is modified, nunc pro tunc as of December 1, 1942, in the following respect:

That sub-division (c) of paragraph (2) of the order contained in said decision, being sub-division (c) of the service regulations therein set forth, be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

"(c) Applicant shall conduct said highway common carrier service over and along the following route, subject to the authority of the Commission to change or modify it at any time by further order:

> "Between Oxnard and Port Eucneme U. S. Naval Training Station, over any and all public streets and highways open to, and available for, motor truck operation."

(2) That in all other respects said Decision No. 35991 shall remain in full force and effect.
