O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct a spur track at grade across San Pedro Avenue in Morgan Hill, Santa Clara County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as (a portion of) Crossing No. E-71-5. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossing shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72 and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach not exceeding those shown on the plan attached to the application. As the construction of this additional track adds to the hazards of the existing crossing, applicant shall, when materials therefor are available, install two Standard No. 3 or Standard No. 8 signals protecting against movements on said existing tracks. Pending such installation applicant is permitted to operate over the crossing herein authorized.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time

be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.
Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience,
necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective
immediately.
