ORDER

The Western Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to construct a side track at grade across Fifth Street and to relocate certain existing tracks at grade across Third and Fourth Streets in Sacramento, Sacramento County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossings Nos. 4-139.15-C; 4-139.3-C; and 4-139.2-C, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation, and of a width to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway and with grades of approach not exceeding four per cent. No additional protection is required at this time.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity, or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
