O R D E R

Southern Pacific Company is authorized to construct two spur tracks at grade across Empire Avenue and one additional side track at grade across Buena Vista Street in Burbank, Los Angeles County, at the location described in the application, to be identified as Crossing No. E-461.3-C and as a portion of Crossing No. E-461.5 respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction of said crossings shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G.O. No. 72, and of a width to conform to the portion of the street now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadway, and with grades of approach approximately as shown on the print attached to the application. Protection shall be by two Standard No. (1) crossing signs (G. O. No. 75-B) at the Empire Avenue Crossing and by two Standard No. 8 Flashing Light Signals at the Buena Vista Street Crossing.

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended, or if above conditions are not complied with.

Authorization may be revoked or modified if public

convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
