ORDER

Pacific Electric Railway Company is authorized to construct a side track at grade across 185th Street and 190th Street in Los Angeles, at the locations described in the application, to be identified as portions of Crossings Nos. 6 RC-15.31 and 6 RC-15.56, respectively. Applicant shall bear entire construction and maintenance expense. Construction shall be equal or superior to Standard No. 2 of G. O. No. 72, without superelevation and of widths to conform to the portions of the streets now graded, with tops of rails flush with roadways, and with grades of approach not exceeding six (6) per cent. Protection at each location shall be by two (2) Standard No. 1 crossing signs. (G. O. No. 75-B)

Within thirty days after completion pursuant to this order, applicant shall so advise the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year (unless time be extended), or if above conditions are not complied with. Authorization may be revoked or modified if public convenience, necessity or safety so require. This order shall be effective immediately.
