BY THE COMMISSION:

O R D E R

The verified application of Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company discloses that but one shipment of freight has been handled at applicant's station of Fountain during the past year and that continued maintenance thereof is not necessary. The only user of the facilities at this station has written the Commission that he has no objection to their removal.

Good Cause Appearing, Northwestern Pacific Railroad Company is authorized to abandon its non-agency station of Fountain, County of Mendocino; to remove a spur track, the shelter shed, and stock pens at said station; to eliminate said name from its station records; and to cancel all tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
