ORDER

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that the amount of passenger and freight business transacted at applicant's station of Watson during the past year no longer warrants its continued maintenance as a Class "C" station. Applicant requests authority to reclassify this station as a Class "B" station where freight in carload lots only will be received or forwarded.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to reclassify its non-agency station of Watson, County of Los Angeles from Class "C" to Class "B"; to remove a team track and the driveway at said station; and to change its tariffs and records accordingly on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
