Decision No. 36128

BEFORE THE RAILROAD COMMISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

In the Matter of the Application of SOUTHERN PACIFIC COMPANY for an order authorizing it to (a) change its Class C Non-Agency Station of Antonio, County of Santa Barbara, State of California, to a Class E Non-Agency Station, and (b) abandon a corral spur track 756 feet in length, also abandon stock corral and freight platform located at said station.

BY THE COMMISSION:

ORDER

The verified application of Southern Pacific Company discloses that the amount of freight business transacted at applicant's Class C Station of Antonio during the past two years no longer warrants its continued maintenance as a Class C station where freight in carload lots or in quantities not over 5,000 lbs. is handled.

Good Cause Appearing, Southern Pacific Company is authorized to reclassify its non-agency station of Antonio, County of Santa Barbara, from Class C to Class E (a station where no freight will be handled); to remove a spur track, a stock corral, and the freight platform at said station; to change its station records accordingly; and to cancel all freight tariffs and time schedules applying at said station on not less than one day's notice to the Commission and the public.

Within thirty days after abandonment and removal of the facilities, as authorized herein, applicant shall so notify the Commission in writing. This authorization shall become void if not exercised within one year, unless time be extended. This order shall be effective immediately.
